U.S. Coast guard Station Ocean City is located at the Southside of Philadelphia Avenue, Bayside. If this activity is chosen and the weather is favorable then families can expect about an hour long boat ride on one of our 47 foot Motor Life Boats as well as a tour of our facility. The hour long boat ride leaves the dock, transits out the inlet and then heads offshore where there may be a possibility that we encounter some type of marine mammal life (dolphins or whales). We highly encourage family members to take pictures and ask plenty of questions. Our crews stand ready to help each family make memorable moments while they are with us. No matter the age, young or old, ASK to take the helm while you are underway with us! We would be more than happy to accommodate any reasonable requests that would help you make your visit with us enjoyable and more so memorable.

Each Family member will be required to wear a lifejacket while on the boat for the duration of the boat ride. These are provided by us and they aren't built for comfort and style as much as they account for safety. Infants and toddlers have extra straps and a head pillow and older kids/adults are just a zippered vest that can be easily worn over your clothing.

All riders are asked to wear sneakers or appropriate shoes (Flip flops can be worn but highly discouraged)

Sunblock should be applied prior to your arrival, we do have some on hand if needed. Please ask for it

We also have a slushie machine for the kiddo's

If you decide to select this activity we can accommodate schedule changes/weather/multiple families if we plan together in advance.

Wednesday afternoon is the normal day for this planned activity.
